- Faculty training!
- Technical assistance
- Time for faculty to learn about technology
- Faculty learn appropriate uses for technology

Features of Effective Learning Technologies

- Instant feedback from online homework and quizzes
- Easy to use
- Self assessments
- Technology is chosen to achieve educational goals
- Students have access to the technology

Do Computers Teach Better Than People?

- Computers by themselves don't teach
- Must be used properly to achieve an educational goal
- Computers by themselves will not improve bad teaching

Do Students Learn More Online Than Face to Face?

- Research on human subjects is difficult to do
- Many studies suggest that students may learn as well online as face to face
- How well students learn is associated with interaction with other students and instructors

Teaching Online Costs Less?

- Networks
- Servers
- Faculty computers
- Faculty training
- Instructional designers, technicians, graphic artists



Computers and Networks Are the Most Expensive Aspect?

- Salaries represent a bigger expense than the technology!
- If students don't learn as much, the money is wasted

- Some will always prefer to teach face to face




Fewer Faculty Will Be Needed?




Limiting Factors




Use of Technology For Teaching Is Low
